

# Targeted Land Stewardship Project 2011

The Targeted Land stewardship Project 2011 aims to recognise and reward stewards of the land for their good land management practices and the environmental goods and services they provide.

The program recognises that the environmental goods and services that result from good land management – clean water, clean air, healthy soils, plants and animals – profit the wider community.

The project pays landowners for environmental goods and services.

## **What's involved?**

- Express your interest
- Invite a project officer to visit your property
- Consider a Land Management Agreement prepared by the officer
- Develop a tender on the costs for implementing the Land Management Agreement
- Submit your tender
- If successful then receive payments to implement Agreement

To be eligible for this project the project size needs to be a minimum of 0.25 ha

You also need to complete a Whole Property Plan.

If you are interested then sign up and consider attending the first stage of the Whole Property Plan coming up in April.
